#### **PARADE RULES**

The Lost Dutchman Parade is a family fun event that is part of the weekend-long Lost Dutchman Days series. The following parade rules help us provide a safe and pleasurable experience for all parade participants and attendees. To ensure a safe parade, violation of any of these rules will result in the disqualification of a parade entry or unit.

#### **ALL ENTRIES**

- One representative from each parade entry must attend a mandatory pre-parade meeting on Tuesday, February 17, 2026, at 6:00pm, Multi-Generational Center, 1035 N Idaho Rd, to receive entry parade position and other important event information.
- All vehicular drivers must possess a valid motor vehicle operator's license and be adequately trained to drive a vehicle in the parade.
- For all vehicular units, proof of vehicular insurance must be received when entry form is submitted for both vehicles and trailers.
- This is an "all forward motion" parade. There will be NO stopping on the parade route to perform. Performing groups/troops should choreograph routines to maintain forward motion at the parade pace. No slow cadences allowed.
- No alcoholic beverages of any kind will be allowed in the staging area nor may be consumed by participants before or during the parade.
- Candy, gifts, or literature of any kind may **NOT** be thrown or handed out to the crowd from any float or unit participating in the parade.
- Failure by a participant or participants parents/guardians to obey any police officer or parade official will be cause for that entry to be removed.
- The number of entries allowed in parade will be based on space available.
- The Parade Committee reserves the right to remove any participant, parent/guardian, or participating unit from the staging area or parade that is, in its opinion, offensive or a hinderance to the progress of the parade, or places other participants or attendees in physical danger, or violates any rules set forth on this application. Any violation of the rules will be grounds for immediate removal from the parade.

#### **WALKING GROUPS**

- Walking groups must not exceed 50 participants.
- Adults must supervise children walking (1:10 adult to child ratio recommended)

#### **EQUESTRIAN GROUPS**

- Equestrian teams and horse drawn carriages/wagons must have parade experience. Rider/driver must always have control of horse(s). Unsafe animals will be removed from parade.
- Equestrian teams and horse drawn carriages/wagons MUST provide own "pooper-scooper" team.

#### **FLOATS**

- Adults must supervise children on floats (1:10 adult to child ratio recommended)
- Floats must be a minimum of 8' in length and be built on a double axel trailer, truck, car, or wagon. Floats, including tow unit, must not exceed 75' in length. Float must be able to make turn at Gold Drive.
- Stabilized props on float should not exceed 15' in width. Must be secured and able to maneuver down parade route.
- Floats must have a minimum of 12" ground clearance from the frame.
   Nothing is permitted to drag from float or hinder float wheels.
- Music is permitted but must maintain a volume that will not interfere with other parade units.
- Use of public address systems for broadcasting messages is prohibited.
- A minimum of one 2A10BC-type fire extinguisher must be provided on each entry or unit.
- Walking groups accompany floats may not exceed 25 participants.
